#### **Biographical/Historical Note**

John Cardinal McCloskey was the first Cardinal in America. He served as Archbishop of New York from 1864 to his death in 1885. Cardinal McCloskey was born in Brooklyn, NY on March 10, 1810. He was a parishioner of St. Peter's Church in Manhattan. He entered Mount St. Mary's College in Emmitsburg. MD in 1821 and then graduated in 1826. A year later he entered the seminary at Mount St. Mary's and was ordained a priest on January 12, 1834. After his ordination, McCloskey travelled to Rome to continue his studies at the Roman College, today Gregorian University. He returned to New York in 1837 and became pastor of St. Joseph's in Greenwich Village. In 1843, McCloskey was elevated to coadjutor to Archbishop Hughes and titular bishop of Axierne. Four years later, McCloskey was appointed Bishop of Albany.

McCloskey remained Bishop of Albany until the death of Archbishop Hughes in 1864, when he was appointed Archbishop of New York. During his tenure as Archbishop, McCloskey opened a new seminary in Troy, St. Joseph's, on Dec. 1, 1864. He also opened the New York Foundling Asylum on October 11, 1869. McCloskey also worked closely with Archbishop Hughes creation, the Catholic Protectory, a place for children who were ineligible for orphanages. He was involved with ecclesiastical matters outside of New York, as he attended the First Vatican Council in from 1869-1870. McCloskey became the first American Cardinal in the Western Hemisphere on March 15, 1875. The decision to elevate him to cardinal was recognition of the growth of the Catholic population in the United States. As Cardinal, he saw to the completion and opening of the new St. Patrick's Cathedral in 1879. McCloskey remained Cardinal of the Archdiocese of New York until his death in 1885.

#### **Scope & Content Note**

The materials in this collection pertain to John Cardinal McCloskey's time as a priest in New York. Most of the collection contains correspondence received by McCloskey as Coadjutor of the Archdiocese of New York, Bishop of New York, and then as Archbishop of New York. These letters range from 1843-1884, with some letters dating to the time before he held these positions. Additional materials, such as class notes and sermons from the 1830s and 1840s, as well as other biographical material relating to McCloskey can also be found in the collection.
