### **Biographical/Historical Note**

On October 2, 1979, Pope John Paul II arrived at LaGaurdia Airport after his trip to Boston. The Pope would spend the next two days traveling throughout New York City, and greeting as many people as possible. Pope John Paul II's visit would be the second time a pope visited the United States of America, the first being Paul VI in 1965. During the first day of his visit, Pope John Paul II addressed the General Assembly at the United Nations for an hour, spent time at the Cardinal's residence at St. Patrick's Cathedral, visited St. Charles Borromeo Church in Harlem, drove past the South Bronx Housing Projects, and finally said mass for 70,000 people at Yankee Stadium. Pope John Paul II began his day on October 3, 1979 with a prayer service at St. Patrick's Cathedral. From there he went to Madison Square Garden for a "Youth in Concert" gathering, in which he spent time with over 20,000 young people from the tri-state area. Afterwards he travelled to Battery Park and addressed New York and the Nation, and ended his trip with a mass at Shea Stadium. That evening he departed from LaGuardia Airport to Philadelphia, the next stop along his American journey.

### **Scope & Content Note**

The materials in this collection date to the time before, during, and after the October 1979 Pope John Paul II visit to New York. Most of the materials deal with the preliminary planning stages of the events that occurred during the pope's visit. Schedules, memorandums, and security information are contained in this collection. Additionally there is correspondence and other files that relate to the specific event sites, such as Yankee Stadium, Battery Park, Shea Stadium, and Madison Square Garden. Ephemera such as programs and tickets and publications such as newspaper clippings and commemorative books can also be found in the collection.
