



## **2023 PIERRE TOUSSAINT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Pierre Toussaint Scholarship Fund (PTSF) and Program were established in 1983 and are administered by the Archdiocese of New York through its Office of Black Ministry. PTSF provides scholarships and mentorship to graduating high school seniors of diverse backgrounds from public, private and parochial schools throughout the Archdiocese of New York, to assist them with the educational fees and expenses associated with their college studies. Students selected into the PTSF, as P.T. Scholars, are chosen based on their strong academic record, their active participation with their parish and school communities, and their demonstration of good character and sound leadership ability. Scholarship awards are renewable for subsequent, consecutive years of undergraduate and graduate studies, based upon the Scholar meeting certain specified academic and service requirements, and other PTSF program requirements.

PTSF also provides scholars with ongoing mentorship and advisement: spiritual, educational, professional career, and personal.

To be eligible for consideration candidates must be an active member of a Roman Catholic Archdiocesan parish, be a graduating high school senior, show high academic achievement and submit the PTSF application with the required documents.
