Focus: God's Wisdom

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 2

And so, it was with me, brothers, and sisters. When I came to you, I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. I came to you in weakness with great fear and trembling. My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power.

We all have a testimony about all that God has done for us. It is interesting how we sometimes may feel unworthy of all that God does for us.
