DAY 5 - April 7 - GOOD FRIDAY FRIDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

Focus: Even now, you will be with me

Scripture: Luke 23:44-49

It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon, for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.

The centurion, seeing what had happened, praised God and said, "Surely this was a righteous man." Reflection:

Looking at the day of Jesus' crucifixion, he still wanted his disciples to know that they will be with him. The two others who were crucified alongside Jesus recognized this and asked, "Jesus remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus made it clear that he had completed God's work and said. "it is finished". What makes it so hard for Jesus to abandon us? He has promised that we will be with him always even in paradise. He shows the people who he is through his works. He tells us that he came to do the work of God who sent him. He reminds us that he has shown us the many good works of God. Our entire life must be to give God the glory for the blessings, works, and grace he pours upon us.
