Catholic Youth Leaders of the Archdiocese

The Catholic Youth Leaders of the Archdiocese (CYLA) is a team of youth in grades 9–12 which represent the various regions of the Archdiocese of New York. CYLA Youth come together for ongoing faith and leadership formation as well as collaboration with the Office of Youth Ministry to meet the needs of and to empower young people in the Archdiocese of New York by:

- Assisting in interpreting the needs of youth and advocating for their concerns to the members
 of Archdiocesan leadership;
- Representing the youth of the archdiocese as servant leaders in various capacities;
- Drawing young people to responsible participation in the life, mission, and work in the faithful community of the People of God;
- Developing and forming the members of the team in leadership skills which will equip them to be servant leaders in their home parish ministries;
- Raising up Catholic leaders in the archdiocese through the team's involvement in the development of programs for youth; and
- Empowering its members to encourage the spiritual and personal growth of their peers by facilitating active participation of youth in archdiocesan events.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

- CYLA application and recommendations from the pastor and youth minister/adult youth leader are due by July 15, 2024. No candidate can be discerned without all the required recommendations.
- All candidates must have the parental consent form signed and included with their application.
- All candidates must be actively involved in youth activities in their parish or school.
- Attendance at the Leadership Training Retreat, CYLA Team Meetings, Summits as well as being committed to planning, implementing and attending youth events at the deanery and diocesan level is required.
- Candidates MUST be present at New York Catholic Youth Day the year they are serving.
