
### **SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING**

#### The I Message

The I Message is a great tool for resolving conflicts and disagreements. It also gives us another way to "Empty Our Balloons."

After we calm our strong emotions with the "Check In" and "Stop and Breathe" techniques, we are able to share how we FEEL and what we NEED.

When we can let down our guard and be vulnerable, the people receiving our I Messages are more likely to be empathetic. This honest communication creates powerful connection within ourselves and with others.

When using the I Message:

- 1. Write down your thoughts and feelings
- 2. Read/Share them aloud
- 3. Acknowledge all of the feelings expressed

Your Truth is yours, not anyone else's.


# **FAITH-BASED TEACHINGS**

Did you know that when you're giving an **I** Message and speaking your truth, you are using fruits of the Holy Spirit? \*Charity,

- \*Kindness,
- \*Gentleness or Humility

#### **CONNECTION SECTION**

#### **KEEP IT REAL AT HOME:**

- Practice using the "I Message"
- Ask children to teach you the hand signals.
- Begin by writing or drawing out your feelings and needs together. Then practice saying them out loud.
- Remember to give children the time and space to think about what they really feel and need. Avoid using leading questions or offering answers. Be patient in waiting for their response.
- Check In: Share a time from your childhood when you had to tell the truth and it was difficult. Share what was in your balloon and how you felt after you did the right thing.
- Discuss John 8:32 and the importance of being free: Free from anxiety, stress, fear and anything else that doesn't allow us to be 100% of who God created us to be. Jesus knows how important it is to be honest.
- Pray as a family for all the different feelings and needs that are shared with each other.
