

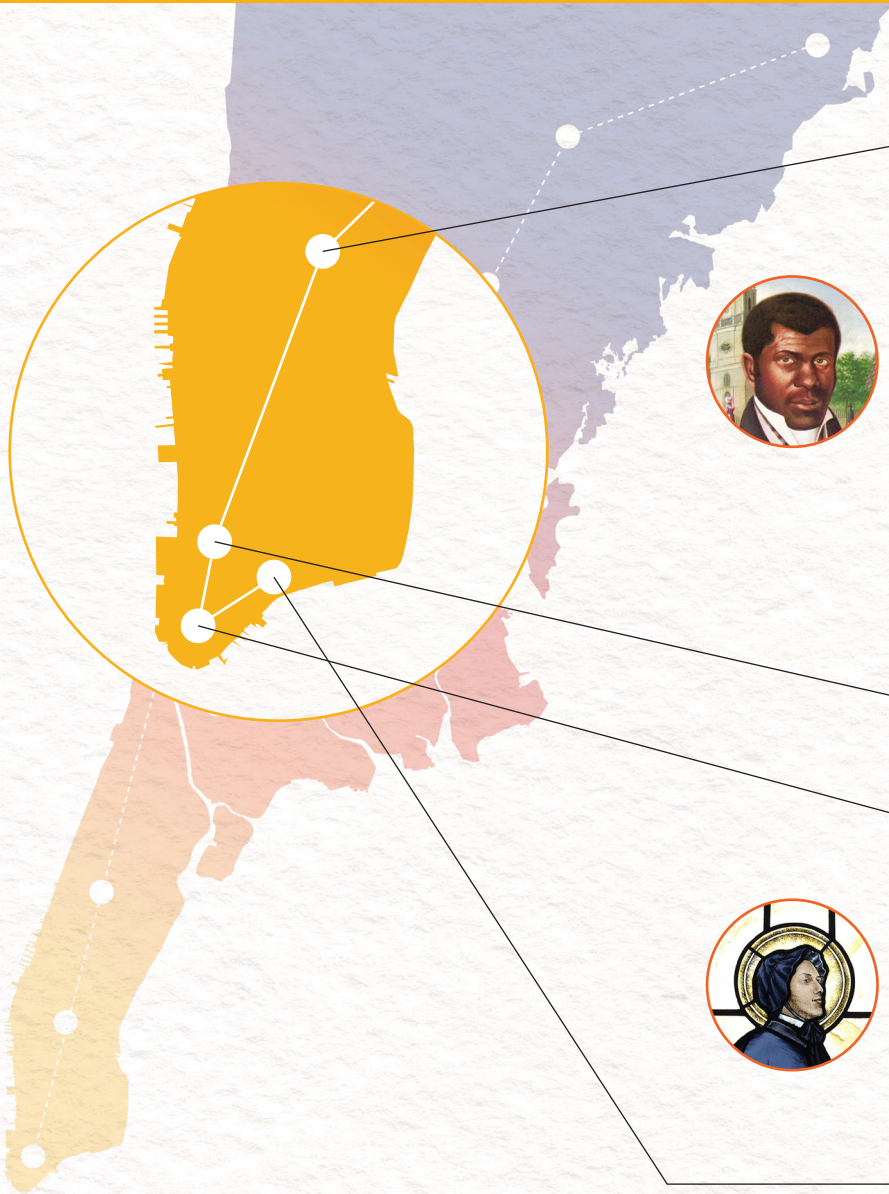

### Venerable Pierre Toussaint

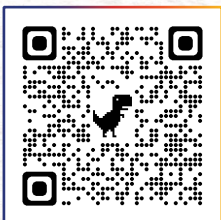
