Dear Father,

God's blessings to you. My goodness, you know well - nothing in these past months has been, or in the near future will be, ordinary or predictable! You have experienced this profoundly, no doubt, in your priesthood, in the life of your parish, and certainly in the lives of the faithful. Accordingly, we have had to adjust the yearly letter to you promoting our ministry of Hope & Healing after abortion.

With the permission from your bishop, we are sending along materials, this year electronically, on our ministry for those who are suffering the effects of abortion, which we hope will help support you in your own ministry of mercy at your parish. This work was very much in the heart of his Eminence, John Cardinal O'Connor. Our Hope & Healing Retreat Ministry includes Days of Prayer and Healing (in English and Spanish), on-going accompaniment through monthly Gatherings, women's study groups, weekend retreats, and other special events. These past months, we added various virtual means of staying connected with the women served in this ministry.

Women who have gone through our ministry have benefited greatly and desire to give back through witnessing to others, volunteering in many varied ways, and supporting other women just beginning the journey of healing. They have courageously spoken to wider audiences, including newly ordained priests, seminarians, high school groups, and parishes – to great effect. Trained counselors are present at every Day of Prayer and Healing.

We have learned that many women will travel distances, for anonymity's sake, to attend our various events, and therefore we would like to continue informing all priests in the tristate dioceses of our Hope & Healing Ministry.
